In order to receive any payments owing to a claimant under the *Brazeau*, *Reddock* and *Gallone* administrative segregation class actions, a claimant incarcerated in a provincial or territorial facility who does not have photo identification, must submit to the claims Administrator (Epiq) a form declaration from a guarantor attesting to their identity. (Protocol 3.13(a))

A guarantor must be:

- Employed within the provincial or territorial correctional facility located in Canada where the claimant is incarcerated (at the time the form is completed/signed), and hold a position that affords them sufficient access to the claimant's personal information/correctional file to meaningfully attest to the identity of the person ;
- Available at the institutional address listed below if the claims Administrator requests further information.
